Urgent: Special Report Item 1 of the provisional agenda* Ad Hoc Committee on an International Convention against the Reproductive Cloning of Human Beings

It has been recently reported to the world community that the Sinclair Research Centre, Columbia, Missouri has made a breakthrough discovery in the field of Human Cloning. It has been reported that the Cell and Immunobiology Core (CIC) has been successfully able to develop and successfully control the cell differentiation pattern post the Blastocyst phase.

This has been the most successful breakthrough in the field ever since March 2013 when the Blastocyst research was reported to us.

In the wake of recent events, The General assembly has called for the Ad-Hoc Committee to discuss and deliberate the further course of action of the UN. This is the closest we have been to the Human Cloning.

We request the member nation's presence on the 15^{th} and 16^{th} of March 2014 for the meeting.
